- ◆ If current diabetes trends continue, as many as 1 out of every 3 adults in the United States could have diabetes by 2050 (CDC Report Card).
- ◆ Kentucky data trends show that diagnosed diabetes among adults has nearly doubled (KY BRFSS Data 2000 -14).

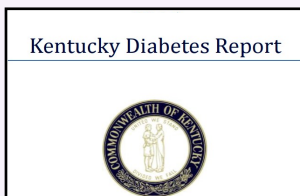
Educational Programs

Kentucky Diabetes Report

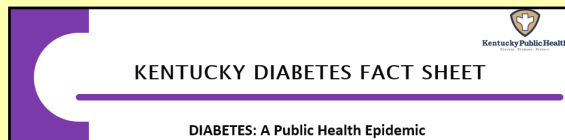
