

2025 Kentucky Legislative Priorities

- Glucagon in Schools (HB 75; HB 174) Allow a health care practitioner to prescribe glucagon in the name of a school rather than an individual student and to allow the school to maintain a supply of the undesignated glucagon for use when necessary.
 - · Pending in House Health Services Committee
- PBM Rebate Reform (SB 12) Require at least 85% of prescription drug rebates to be passed through to covered individuals at the point of sale..
 - · Pending in Senate Banking and Insurance Committee
